AN ACT to Amend the Agricultural Development Corporation Act so as to change the name of the Act; and for connected matters.

[*1st June, 2009*]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Agricultural Development Corporation (Change of Name) Act, 2010, and shall be read and construed as one with the Agricultural Development Corporation Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of June, 2009.

2. The principal Act is amended in the title and in sections 1, 2, and 3 (1) by deleting the words “Agricultural Development” wherever they appear and substituting therefor, in each case, the word “Agro-Investment”.
