

THE FOREST ACT

The Forest (Tryall Estate Forest Reserve) Order, 2016

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 5 (b) of the Forest Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:-

- Citation. 1. This Order may be cited as the Forest (Tryall Estate Forest Reserve) Order, 2016.
- Schedule. 2. The areas specified in Part I of the Schedule which is delineated on the map set out in Part II thereof, is hereby declared to be a forest reserve and shall be known as Tryall Estate Forest Reserve.

Part I. Description of area declared to be Tryall Estate Forest Reserve

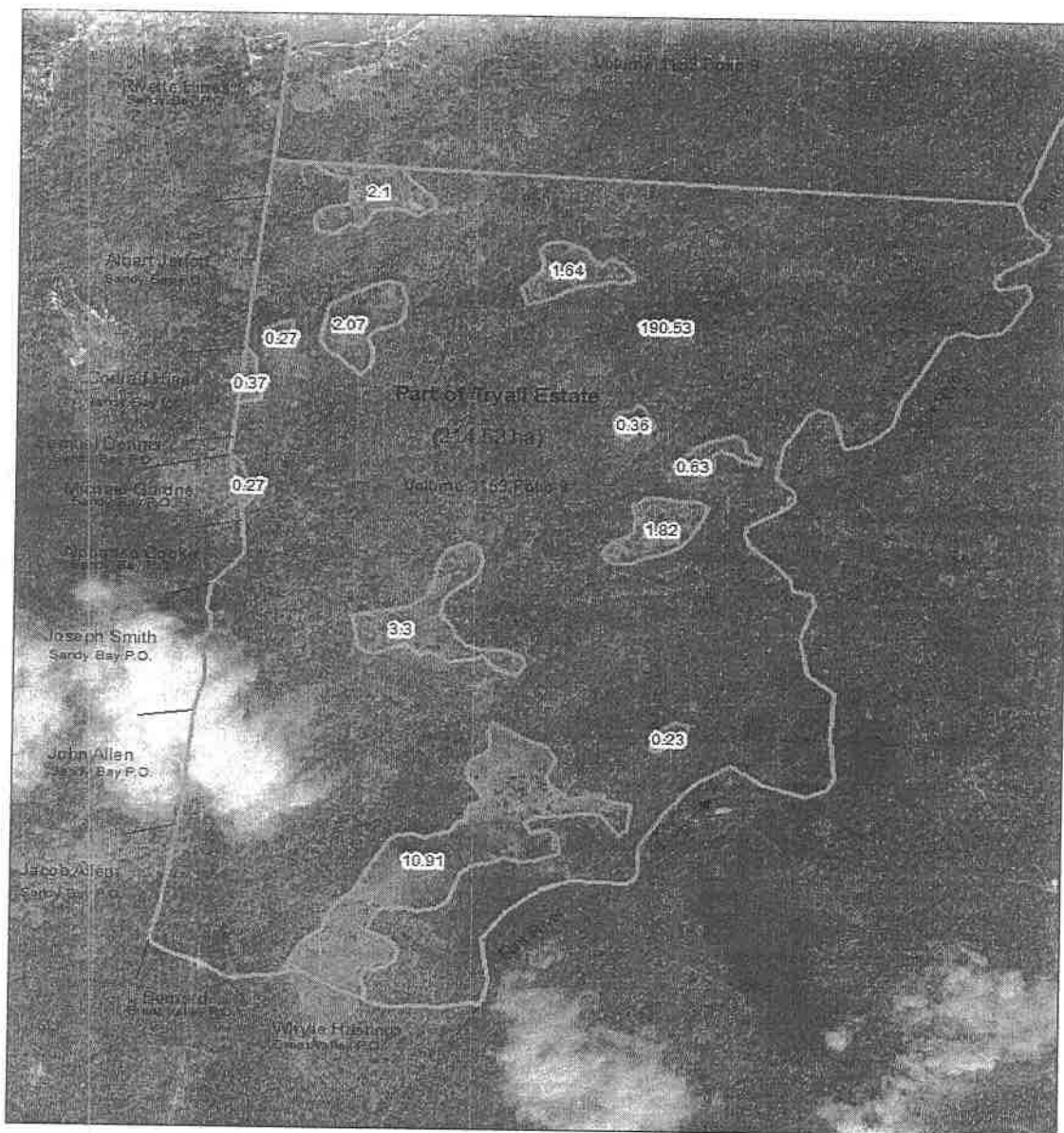
The forest reserve to be known as Tryall Estate Forest Reserve, is described as follows:

All that parcel of land situated in the parish of Hanover being part of Tryall Estate, registered at Volume 1159 Folio 9 and containing 214.52 hectares more or less and butting and bounding as follows -
