**The Forest (Oxford Forest Reserve)  
Order Resolution, 2016**

---

**WHEREAS** by virtue of section 5(a) of the Forest Act (hereinafter referred to as the Act) provides that the Minister may by order declare any Crown land as a forest reserve:

**AND WHEREAS** by virtue of section 10(1)(a) of the Act provides that before an order is made under section 5(a), the Minister shall publish a notice of his intention to make the order and invite in such manner as the Minister thinks fit, comments from the members of the public in relation to such order:

**AND WHEREAS** by virtue of section 10(1)(b) of the Act, the prescribed ninety days since the publication of the notice has passed:

**AND WHEREAS** by virtue of section 5 of the Act, an order made under paragraph (a) shall be subject to affirmative resolution:

**AND WHEREAS** it is desirable that the Forest (Oxford Forest Reserve) Order, 2016, be affirmed:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives as follows:-

1. This Resolution may be cited as the Forest (Oxford Forest Reserve) Order Resolution, 2016.
2. The Forest (Oxford Forest Reserve) Order Resolution, 2016, is hereby affirmed.
