AN ACT to Amend the Minimum Wage Act.

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and

with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Minimum Wage (Amendment) Act. Short title 2011, and shall be read and construed as one with the Minimum Wage and Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) and all amendments

2. The principal Act is amended by deleting section 13 and substituting Repeal and therefor the following-

of section 13

"Regulations. 13.—(1) The Minister may make regulations of principal generally for giving effect to the provisions of this Act.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 29(b) of the *Interpretation Act*, regulations made under this Act may provide for the imposition of greater penalties than those specified in that section so, however, that the maximum penalty that may be imposed on summary conviction in a Resident Magistrate's Court shall be a fine not exceeding one million dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both such fine and imprisonment."
