The Pensions (Amendment of Schedule)  
Regulations, 2012

---

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 3 of the Pensions Act, and every other power hereunto enabling, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations, 2012, and shall be read and construed as one with the Pensions Act and all amendments thereto.

2. Part III of the Appendix to the regulations set out in the Schedule to the Act is amended -

(a) in paragraph 2 by deleting sub-paragraph (h) and inserting the following as sub-paragraphs (h) to (k) -

"(h) in respect of an officer who dies from injuries received on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2000, but before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2005, not exceed -

(i) four million dollars; or

(ii) the aggregate of the amounts specified in sub-paragraph (a)(iii),

whichever is the greater;

(i) in respect of an officer who dies from injuries received on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2005, but before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2006, not exceed -

(i) four million five hundred thousand dollars; or

(ii) the aggregate of the amounts specified in sub-paragraph (a)(iii),

whichever is the greater;

(j) in respect of an officer who dies from injuries

received on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2006, but before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2008, not exceed -

(i) six million dollars; or

(ii) the aggregate of the amounts specified in sub-paragraph (a)(iii),

whichever is the greater;

(k) in respect of an officer who dies from injuries received on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2008, not exceed -

(i) eight million dollars; or

(ii) the aggregate of the amounts specified in sub-paragraph (a)(iii),

whichever is the greater.";

(b) by deleting paragraph 3.


